- 4. Ms. Hubner Counseling information:
- Ms. Hubner has been in education for 12 going on 13 year
- She is Windsor's Level 1 investigator (with Ms. Lozen)
- She is Windsor's trainer for CPI
- DMPS does not a cohesiveness throughout the district for counseling
- ?DMPS is adopting an ASKA National Plan
- Ms. Hubner uses data collected from students for the first half of year and then from Panorama for the second half to see who can use assistance in possible small group or individual work.
  - Will work on individualized small groups for 6 times- this could be not consecutive so could take up to 9 weeks.
  - These groups mainly work on self control, self regulation, and or friendships
  - o Individual counseling is very hands on and in the moment
  - o Parent referral, data collected, ???or staff recommendation can get a one on one individual counseling referral
